#### 1. INTRODUCTION

STLVS is a legality system covering the process of licensing, harvesting, transporting, manufacturing and trading of logs and timber products in accordance with the existing laws, regulations and procedures governing forests and timber trade (including the importation of logs and timber products) in Sarawak. It governs the forestry management and operations as well as the supply chain of timber products. Timber traceability in Sarawak starts from the path taken by the movement of logs from the forests (natural or PFs) to either the mills or export points, including log identification, recording of production, royalty assessment and control of log movement. Cross checking is carried out to ensure that the logs in the supply chain are verified legal.

STLVS compliance certification is a formal verification or a due diligance process that verify a timber product originates from legal sources, has been harvested, transported, processed, and traded in compliance with Sarawak's forestry laws and regulations and has meet the standards set by the STLVS Standard & Principles. STLVS consists of 6 Principles, covering:

Principle 1 – Right to Harvest		
Principle 2 – Forest Operations	Forest Department Sarawak (FDS)	
Principle 3 – Statutory Charges	Forest Department Sarawak (FDS)	
Principle 4 – Other User Rights		
Principle 5 – Mill Operations	Sarawak Timber Industry Development	
Principle 6 – Trade and Customs	Corporation (STIDC)	

STIDC will issue the STLVS Certificate of Compliance for Principles 5 and 6 upon successful completion of a third-party audit conducted by a registered and independent auditor, based on the STLVS standards

#### 2. OBJECTIVES

STLVS Compliance Certification serves as a due diligance to verify that all timber and timber products harvested, processed, and traded in Sarawak originate from legal sources and comply with existing forestry laws and regulations. It is also as a basis to meet the legality verification expectations of importing countries (e.g., EU, US, Australia) under regulations like the EUDR), Lacey Act, Goho Wood and others.



The current and future market for timber products has shown that most buyers are going for certified products. The certification would also provide their customers the confidence as Sarawak Timber Legality Verification System (STLVS) connects the business to responsible forest management practices.

SANYAN has obtained PEFC Chain of Custody certificate, certificate #: SIRIM C0C 0034 for their products (Floor Base, Structural Panel, Concreate Panel, Coated Panel and Stelluna Coated Panel) with expiry date on 14 January 2023.

#### 3. REPORT ON FINDINGS

3.1 Documents assessed and adequacy of documented system and record keeping

SANYAN had prepared a document entitled "STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES FOR SARAWAK TIMBER LEGALITY VERIFICATION SYSTEM" (SOP) dated 1 July 2018 which contains written instructions to guide its staff on the implementation of the timber legality verification system for STLVS verified logs and panel products in accordance to the requirements of the Standard for Verification of Forest Management, Mill Operations, Trade & Customs STLVS Principles 5 – 6 which hereafter referred as STLVS standard.

The SOP has described the flow of activities of SANYAN's business operations from the purchase of STLVS verified logs to the production and sales of the STLVS verified products [Floor Base, Structural Panel, Concreate Panel, Coated Panel and Steluna Coated Panel]; outlined the organization structure, responsibilities, authorities and documented the control procedures that fulfill the requirement of STLVS standard.

All relevant documents were sighted and it was found that the documented system has complied with the requirements of the STLVS standard. As required in the SOP, all relevant records relating to the STLVS verified system will be maintained for a minimum of 5 years. Based on the samples of related records on purchase of logs and sale of panel products, they were found to be adequate for tracing from the origins of the logs used in manufacturing of the panel product and to the buyer.
